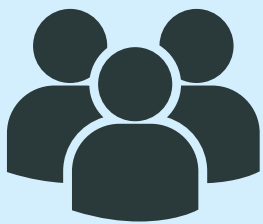

## JANAMASHTAMI CELEBRATION

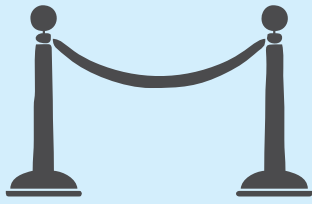

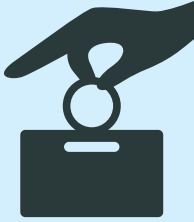
